

Worship Training 4-5 Class Schedule

Teachers – Look over the lesson the week before to ready yourself, pray, and make sure you have needed supplies (contact Shannon with questions – shannontemple74@gmail.com)

Before the service:

Team meets at 9:00 to discuss the lesson and pray.

Make sure that chairs and supplies are out and ready to ensure the flow of the lesson.

* Exit Worship

Rope line to classroom

* Settle into Chairs

Pass out Children's Order of Worship

* Recite Deuteronomy 6:4-9

“Hear O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is One (*holding up one finger*).

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart (*put your hands over your heart*), and with all your soul (*inhale and exhale with a deep breath*), and with all your might (*flex muscles*). And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. You shall teach them diligently to your children and shall talk of them when you sit in your house (*hands making a peaked roof*), and when you walk by the way (*walk fingers across palms*), and when you lie down (*hands beside head to gesture sleep*), and when you rise (*push palms upward*). You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. You shall write them on the doorpost of your house and on your gates.”

* Singing/Music

Guitarist leads children in learning and singing songs.

Adult workers sing with children (sheet music in box).

* Passing of the Peace

Leader: “May the peace of the Lord be with you.”

Children and workers: “And also with you.”(greet each other)

* Restroom Break--ALL CHILDREN GO

Line up in boy/girl lines.

Two adults of same gender in bathroom with children. Line up inside bathroom until all children are finished and have washed hands. Return to hallway outside the classroom.

* Chiming of the Hour

Pick a child to ring the bell then enter the classroom and be seated.

* Confession of Sin

“Jesus we have not loved you with all of our hearts, all of our souls, and all of our might. We have not loved you with all of our thoughts, all of our feelings, and all of our actions.” (break down in short phrases for children to repeat)

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* Assurance of Pardon

“There is now no condemnation, no punishment for us who belong to Jesus through faith.” (break down in short phrases for children to repeat)



* Prayer



* Lesson

Open Bible to text. Instruct from teacher manual, with visual aids and individual creativity.



* Closing Song



* Benediction

Leader: “The Lord bless you and keep you.”

Children and workers: “Come quickly, Lord Jesus! Amen.”

* Activity

Direct children to tables.

Assign all workers to tables.

Pass out supplies/workers help children at table.

If there is extra time:

Choose a key concept from the lesson and have children draw about it on a plain sheet of paper.

If the lesson is a narrative, have the children act it out.

At Home Sheet

Charades with words from the lesson

Games (Simon Says, Duck-Duck-Goose, Hot Potato, etc.)

On Non-Communion Sundays:

Two workers stand at the door and work together to retrieve children, take ID stickers and place on roll sheet, and send home Take Home materials.

On Communion Sundays:

The class will last about 40 minutes from the time you leave the service to when you are called back, so try to plan accordingly.

A deacon will come tell the class when communion is about to begin. The teachers will walk the class in to the left door of the theater. Children will be released to their parents.
